

SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACT

BACKGROUND

Abstracts have a **300 word limit** or text (not including presenter information and title)

Abstracts must be in word format incorporating the following

Font: Times New Roman 12p
First level heading: Flush left, bold and upper and lower case
Spacing: Leave one line of space
Next Line: Align left, being typing body text
Recommend: One paragraph with a maximum length of one page

The abstract should contain the following elements:

The topic (s) that will be addressed

Name, title, company affiliation, e-mail and full address of the author (s)

Introduction/objective: a brief statement of your paper

Methods/design: describe the research, outcome measures and statistical methods used.

Results: list the most important findings

Conclusions: List the most important findings and recommendations.

Acceptance to the program is determined solely by the TechCon[®] Asia Pacific Advisory Committee based on a review of the abstract and its subject matter. Confirmation of the approval status of your paper will be sent by December 2011 or earlier.

BIOGRAPHY

Please include a short biography of about 80 words of the presenter, so the session chair can introduce them properly, this includes:

Full name

Title

Description of current responsibilities in the first paragraph

Educational background in the last paragraph
